Five-finger glove with cuff long 6.5 cm, seams with aramid thread.

Palm of the glove:

External fabric: para-aramid fiber 100% joined internally with fabric viscose FR 100% 750±5% g/m² yellow art. "A 379 K"

Blue lining quilted with felt: aramid 50% and viscose FR 50% 290±5% g/m² art. "Firestop"

Back and cuff of the glove:

Aluminized fabric: meta-aramid 95% and para-aramid 5% 350±5% g/m² art. "TECH/M/080"

Blue lining quilted with felt: aramid 50% and viscose FR 50% 290±5% g/m² art. "Firestop"

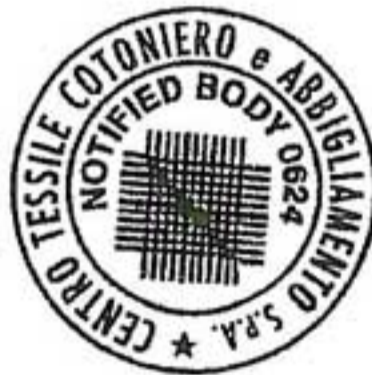
- The present certificate has 5-year validity from the date of issue. On expiration date it will be responsibility of the Manufacturer to ask for the renewal.
